THESE ARE GUIDES THAT WILL HELP YOU THROUGH CEDAR HILL CEMETERY IN PORT JEFFERSON, N.Y. AND OTHER LOCAL CEMETERIES TO THE GRAVESITES OF PROMINENT PEOPLE OF THE FOUNDING FAMILIES OF PORT JEFFERSON, PORT JEFFERSON STATION AND TERRYVILLE. AS YOU WALK THROUGH THESE CEMETERIES, AS I INCLUDED IN THE ‘SUPPLEMENT’: SEAVIEW CEMETERY, MT.SINAI; SETAUKET PRESBYTERIAN CHURCHYARD, SETAUKET; CAROLING-BROOKHAVEN EPISCOPAL CHURCHYARD, SETAUKET; OAR HILL CEMETERY, STONY BROOK; ST. JAMES EPISCOPAL CHURCHYARD, VILLAGE OF HEAD OF THE HARBOR, ST JAMES; AND WAVERLY CEMETERY, HOLTSVILLE.

I HAVE WALKED THROUGH THESE CEMETERIES AND OTHERS MANY TIMES AND STILL CONTINUE TO DO SO. THE RESEARCH NEVER ENDS. . THERE ARE DAYS WHEN I CANNOT DRIVE PASS A LOCAL CEMETERY WITHOUT STOPPING AND LOOKING TO SEE WHO IS THERE. THERE ARE MANY SMALL PRIVATE CEMETERIES ALL AROUND LONG ISLAND, SOME ARE KEPT IN GOOD CONDITION AND SADLY, SOME ARE NOT. BUT, I DO WHAT I CAN WHILE I AM VISITING TO HELP CLEAN THE AREA. SOME OF THESE CEMETERIES HAVE A HISTORY THAT GOES BACK INTO THE 1600s AND 1700s THAT CANNOT BE IGNORED.

THE BROOKHAVEN TOWN HISTORIAN OFFICE AND THE INTERNET ARE GREAT TOOLS IN FINDING THESE CEMETERIES AND FOR MOST, THERE ARE ‘GRAVESITE’ NAME LISTS AND A LIST OF SUPERINTENDENTS WHO ARE IN CHARGE OF THESE CEMETERIES FOR THEIR CONDITION AND KNOW WHO ARE INTERRED IN THEM. I HAVE FOUND BURIAL SITES IN THE MIDDLE OF THE WOODS WITH ONE OR TWO SITES AND WONDER WHO THESE PEOPLE WERE AND WHY THEY ARE IN THESE SECLUDED AREAS. ONE SITE IS NEAR ‘WHISKEY ROAD’ AND IS IN TERRIBLE CONDITION AND ANOTHER INTERESTING SITE IS IN THE MIDDLE OF A PARKING LOT OF A ‘HOME DEPOT’ STORE. THERE ARE MANY CEMETERIES, WHICH CAN BE FOUND, BEHIND THE FAMILY HOME OR ON THE PROPERTY SOMEWHERE. THE ‘WILLIAM FLOYD ESTATE’ HAS THEIR ‘SLAVES’ BURIED JUST OUTSIDE THE GATED AREA OF THE FLOYD FAMILY PLOTS. I AM TOLD BECAUSE THAT THE SLAVES WERE SEPARATED FROM THE LIVES OF THE PROMINENT FAMILIES IN LIFE, THEY ARE SEPARATED IN ‘DEATH’ AS WELL.
