Mr. Jarvis was the son of Simon Losee Jarvis and Keturah Conklin, the other children being Robert, David C., Thomas H., Elizabeth, Esther, Jonathan, Phebe, Philetus C., Ira, Almira, Emilous and John B. One other child died when quite young. The only survivor is Emilous, of this village. Deceased was born in this place September 25, 1818, and was a life-long resident of the town. His early years were spent at home, he afterward following the water with his brother Philetus, engaging in the lumber business. Upon purchasing a farm at Town Hill he turned his attention to farming, which business he has pursued for many years. When a young man he married Martha Bunce, of Northport, who died several years ago. As a fruit of the marriage five daughters survive: Mrs. Nelson Sammis and Miss Hattie Jarvis, of Brooklyn; Mrs. William P. Smith, of Amityville, and Mrs. Mary Conklin and Mrs. Anna Limberg, of this village. The Rev. Samuel H. Seem conducted the funeral service at his late residence Tuesday afternoon.

Death claimed on Sunday last a well known citizen. William H. Jarvis of Town Hill. Mr. Jarvis had lived to the ripe old age of 82 yrs., 9 mo., and 19 days, and although his years indicated that the final summons might be expected at any time, up to within a comparatively short time of his death he was unusually rugged and well. He bore out fully the reputation of his branch of the Jarvis family for longevity.

Mr. Jarvis was a native of and always resided in this town.

He was number thirteen in a family of fourteen children
born to Simon Losee Jarvis and Keturah Conklin, who were
married in 1791. The children were Robert, David C.,
Thomas H. and Elizabeth, (twins), Esther, Jonathan, Phebe
and Philetus C., Ira, Almira, Emilus, William H., John B.,
and one child which died in infancy. Of this family Esther
lived to be 80 years old, Phebe for more than 90 years,
Philetus to 84, Almira to nearly 80 years, Jonathan to more
than 97, the others to good ages. Of this large family
Emilius who resides on Mill Street this village is the

surviving member. His is now 85 years old and enjoys fair health.

He married Miss Martha Bunce of Northport. She died several years ago. Mr. Jarvis leaves surviving, five daughters, as follows: Mrs. Nelson Sammis, Miss Mattie Jarvis of Brooklyn, Mrs. William P. Smith of Amityville, Mrs. Mary Conklin and Mrs. Annie Limberg of this place.

Mr. Jarvis was a most companionable man. He was however emphatic in his ideas and when once his mind was made up was inflexible. He had a large circle of acquaintances and was well posted in affairs of the olden time. The funeral was held from his late residence on Tuesday, the Rev. S. H. Seem of the Central Church officiating. The pall bearers were C. D. Smith, E. L. Hogan, A. S. Pettit, C. E. Sammis, J. N. Sammis and George Ferguson.

SIXTY YEARS MARRIED

Mr. and Mrs. Emilous Jarvis
Celebrate the Anniversary

One of Huntington's Old Couples

Remarkable Record Of The Family Of Jarvis.

He Who Would Have a Second Wife Should Not Marry a Jarvis-A Little Of The Family History.

Huntington, March 7. -- Mr. and Mrs. Emilous Jarvis, Jr., celebrated the sixtieth anniversary of their wedding at their home in this village last evening. They are the second couple known of in this town who have enjoyed so many years of married life, the other being Mr. and Mrs. David F. Barney, who a few weeks ago passed their sixtysecond anniversary. Mr. Barney is 84 years old; Mrs. Barney, 81. They retain their faculties and are able to be at their work every day. Mr. Barney has a loom where he weaves rag carpets.

Mr. and Mrs. Jarvis came from long-lived families on both sides. A few years ago it was said that a man who expected or desired to marry a second time must not marry a Jarvis girl, for they live forever. Mrs. Jarvis was Miss Maria Brown, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Mica Brown, of Northport.

She was one of six children, and was born in April, 1819, making her 80 years old next month. Two of her brothers are residing in Northport to-day--Arden Brown, aged 75, and George Brown, aged 71.

Mr. Jarvis comes from a family noted for its longevity. He was the son of Simon Losea Jarvis and Katurah Conkilin, who were married in 1791, and was born October 28, 1815, making him 85 years old. He was one of fourteen children, all of whom lived to good ages except one, who died very young. Of this family Esther lived to be 80 years old; Phoebe, to more than 90 years; Philetus, to over 84 years, and Almira, to nearly 80 years. William H., a farmer in Town Hill, is yet active and attends to his business. He was 80 years of age last September.

Emilous Jarvis goes about his work every day and attends to it. He is a wheelwright. He was seen at his shop yesterday. He is wonderfully well preserved. He is quite stout, with a full gray beard, except for his upper lip, which he keeps closely shaved. His frame is a sturdy one, His eyes are bright; not a single wrinkle mars his cheeks, which have the red glow of health. He remarked to the Brooklyn Times correspondent that he was in better health yesterday than he was fifty years ago. He talked of scenes and events of seventy years ago. He stated that he never can forget the day he left the old carriage shop at the east end of the town to go to his wedding. Uncle Ebenezer Jarvis, whose widow is still living in this village, called to the shop workers: "Here he goes, boys; come and get a last look at

The wedding took place at the residence of Mr. Jarvis' sister, Mrs. Jesse Sammis, March 6, 1839. They resided in a house in East Neck. It stood between the two roads near the present home of Gilbert Scudder. The Rev. Hugh McDougall performed the ceremony. The weather was much colder than that of this season.

him."

Mr. and Mrs. Jarvis have two children, Mrs. George Hunt, of 892 Putnam avenue, Brocklyn, and Mrs. Fred L. Hamilton, of Stamford, Conn. Mrs. Jarvis, except for attacks of rheumatism, does her own housework and enjoys it. Mr. Jarvis has always been active. He has followed his trade first in this place, then at Lakeville, near Manhasset, at Westbury, New York City, Brocklyn and in Huntington since 1862. There has been three golden weddings in this family—those of Philetus Jarvis and wife, Jesse Sammis and wife, Almira Jarvis, and that of Mr. and Mrs. Emilous Jarvis. It is a strange coincidence that the oldest man in the town Uncle "Tommy" Scudder, now 98 years old, should be connected by marriage with a branch of the Jarvis family.

The celebration last evening was a very quiet one. Relatives and friends to the number of a dozen enjoyed a supper with the aged couple. None enjoyed it more than Mr. and Mrs. Jarvis. They were as youthful in talk as any of the guests. There was no doubt in the minds of any present of future anniversaries to be enjoyed under the Jarvis roof. Those who helped mark the advanced milestone in Mrs. and Mrs. Jarvis' life were Mr. and Mrs. George C. Martling, Mrs. S. Lee Jarvis, Miss Grace Jarvis, Mrs. Philip Pearsall, Mrs. Edward H. Dodge, of Manhasset; Mrs. William Stoyle, Mrs. George H. Brock, Miss Annie Grant, Mrs. Thomas Aitkin, Mrs. John Fleet, the Misses Margaret and Sarah Cumberson.

Mr. and Mrs. Jarvis celebrated the sixty-third anniversary of their wedding day on March 6 last.

Maria, wife of Emilous Jarvis, sr., died last night at ll o'clock. She had been very feeble for a long time and her death was not unexpected. Mr. Jarvis lies very ill, being unconscious most of the time, and his life cannot last much longer. She was 84 years of age and he is 87. March 6. 1889, they celebrated their golden wedding anniversary, and in 1899 they were privileged to enjoy a sixty-year celebration. They were married March 6, 1839, at the home of Mr. Jarvis' sister, Mrs. Jesse Sammis, at East Neck, near the present home of Gilbert Scudder, the officiating clergyman being the Rev. James McDougall. Mrs. Jarvis was Miss Maria Brown, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Micah Brown, of Northport. She was one of six children and was born in April, 1819. Two daughters were born to Mr. and Mrs. Jarvis, Mrs. George Hunt. of Brooklyn. and Mrs. Fred. L. Hamilton. of Stamford, Conn. A Double Funeral

A scene most impressive was witnessed by those in attendance at the funeral services of Mr. and Mrs. Emilous Jarvis, sr., at their late residence on Mill street Tuesday afternoon at 20°clock. Together in life for 64 years, death separated them only for a short time. Mrs. Jarvis died Thursday night and her husband followed Monday morning. The services were conducted by the Rev. Samuel H. Seem, pastor of the Central Presbyterian church with which the old people had long been connected. The pallbearers were W. Woodhull Sammis, John Ferguson, Alonzo P. Dodge, Philip Pearsall, H. V. Baylis and H. A. Baylis. Two hearses were used and the bodies were interred side by side, in one large grave.

Mr. Jarvis did not know of his wife's death as he was unconscious most of the time for several days before his decease. Both had been ill several weeks and each felt the gravest concern for the other's well fare. Although 87 years of age Mr. Jarvis was seen about the street in November, but because of rheumatism had to give up work in his wheelwright shop about six months ago. He was a wonderfully well preserved man, well built, and wore a full gray beard save the hair of his upper lip being shaved. A few years ago he remarked that he never felt in better health in his life. The old man used to tell with great interest of the day he left the old carriage shop at the east end of the town to go to his wedding. Uncle Ebenezer Jarvis, who owned the business, called to the shop workers: "Here he goes, boys: come and get a last look at him."

Deceased comes from a wonderfully long lived family, and it has often been said a man who expected or desired to marry a second time, should not marry a Jarvis, as they are liable to live forever. He was the son of Simon Losea Jarvis and Keturah Conklin, who were married in 1791, and was born October 28, 1815, making him 87 years old. He was one of fourteen children, all of whom lived to good ages except one, who died very young. Of this family Esther

lived to be 80 years old; Phoebe, to more than 90 years; Philetus, to over 84 years; Almira to nearly 80 years; Jonathan to 97 years, and William H., to 82.

Mr. and Mrs. Jarvis, leave two children, Mrs. George Hunt, of 892 Putnam avenue, Brooklyn, and Mrs. Fred L. Hamilton, of Stamford, Conn. Mr. Jarvis has followed his trade first in this place, then at Lakeville, near Manhasset, at Westbury, New York city, Brooklyn and in Huntington since 1862.

There has been three golden weddings in this family--those of Philetus Jarvis and wife, Jesse Sammis and wife, Almira Jarvis, and that of Mr. and Mrs. Emilous Jarvis. On March 6, 1889, Mr. and Mrs. Jarvis celebrated their golden wedding anniversary and ten years later enjoyed the sixty year celebration.

Both the deceased were highly respected by a large circle of relatives and friends, and the brave manner in which they bore their ills and pains during the last days of their life afforded ample proof of their Christian trust and

virtue.

I called Miss Alice M. Bedell by phone and from her got information regarding Edwin J. Bedell, which is as follows: Alice B. Bedell, his first wife, divorced him sometime after 1895 and married Charles Allen Rose, and they

are now residing at 672 Ocean Avenue, Brooklyn, N. Y.

She also informed me that Edwin J. Bedell remarried - one Stella P. I have also learned that Edwin J. Bedell died in July, 1921 at Richmond Hill, and is buried in Greenfield Cemetery, Hempstead. About 1900 or later, Edwin J. Bedell and Stella P. adopted a nephew of Stella P. (Adoption in Kings County.) Frank H. Bedell. He is now residing at Queens Village with his wife Myrtle D. Bedell. Stella P. Bedell is residing in Allwood, New Jersey.

In my conversation with Miss Alice M. Bedell, I told her of your work on the Bedell Family and what meagre information you had concerning her particular branch of the family. She stated that she would be very glad to give you what information she could. She at least can give you sometime on the three generations which have come into being and maybe able to give you something regarding her ancestors. I gave her your name and told her to address you in care of the Long Island Collection.

I also picked up the following facts which of course, do not pertain to the Edwin L. J. Bedell part of the family, but you may find a place for them in some other branch.
