Introduction

For the historian and genealogist, cemeteries are vast repositories of information about the past. Within the pre-1920 boundaries of the Town of Oyster Bay are located some of the very oldest cemeteries to be found anywhere in New York State. The earliest cemeteries were small family plots such as the Townsend or Mill Hill cemetery located just to the west of the Mill Pond in Oyster Bay. This was a family burial plot for Henry Townsend, who built the first mill in Oyster Bay in 1661 and was buried on his own property. In nearby Oyster Bay Cove, the Youngs family set aside a plot of their own land for a family burying place in 1658. Today, this family burying plot also contains the grave of Theodore Roosevelt, 26th President of the United States. Various church groups began cemeteries in the later part of the 17th century, the earliest being the Friends, who set aside a cemetery on the west side of South Street in Oyster Bay in 1672.

Interest in the documentation of the early burials within the Town goes back to the 1800s when some historians and family researchers began recording the inscriptions on the stones in some of the very oldest cemeteries. Samuel Youngs wrote about the difficulty finding the gravestones of the earliest settlers of Oyster Bay and many had disappeared even by the early 1800s; whether Samuel Youngs made any transcriptions is unknown. He, no doubt, was feeling some frustration even then as revealed in a short verse he wrote in the early 1800s;

"Where are the stones that mark the bones Of those who die in Oyster Bay? There are no stones to mark the bones Of those who die in Oyster Bay."

The earliest surviving records of cemetery transcriptions is entitled "Oldest Inscriptions in Burial Grounds in this Vicinity" by Jacob T. Bowne. Bowne's 1867 record covered a few cemeteries in the Glen Cove area. These efforts were followed by many researchers in the latter part of the 19th century. Most notable of these later researchers was Josephine Frost, who compiled information previously gathered by William Wyckoff on cemeteries throughout Long Island.

Over the years, many headstones have disappeared from the old cemeteries; some were used in building foundations, as door stoops, and for walkways. During the Revolutionary War, Hessian and British soldiers reportedly desecrated many local graves and took headstones to use for various purposes. Many family cemeteries simply disappeared, while some were removed to larger public cemeteries. Many remaining gravestones have deteriorated so much that they are now completely unreadable. Unfortunately, in many cases, the transcription records made by those early historians and family researchers are now all that remain.

Purpose of This Guide

The purpose of this guide to **Historic Cemeteries of Oyster Bay** is to be of assistance to genealogical and historical researchers in determining the locations of the historic cemeteries within the pre-1920 boundaries of the Town of Oyster Bay and to serve as a guide to where transcription records can be found. The guide includes all known cemeteries that have ever existed within the Town of Oyster Bay. Although 23 of the cemeteries listed in this guide no longer exist, several individuals in the distant and not so distant past had the foresight to record the information that was then still present. Some records exist as the direct result of WPA projects during the 1930s. As one peruses the various sets of transcriptions beginning in the nineteenth century and up through those completed in the 1960s by Town of Oyster Bay Historian Herbert Hale, the ravages of time on the old stone inscriptions become clearly evident.

This guide does not suggest, nor does it encourage, visits for information gathering purposes to any of the historic cemeteries listed within it. Whatever information remains on the surviving stones is clearly much less than what was transcribed years ago and the sources for obtaining those transcription records are included within this guide.

Usage of this guide

The cemeteries listed within this guide are arranged first by present day locality and then alphabetically by the most commonly known name of the cemetery; also included is a listing of all known names of the cemeteries. The names and descriptions of the locations were taken from the old transcription records; in some cases, the points of reference no longer exist. At least one transcription record is listed for each named cemetery and, in many cases, there are multiple records. Some of the cemeteries contained in this guide are still active; researchers seeking information relative to active cemeteries should be able to find inscription information by contacting those cemeteries.

Bayville

(1) **Bayville Cemetery Inc.**

Bayville Avenue
Earliest stone dated 1812, most date from 1830s and later.
Active-Records at Bayville Village Hall.
Partial Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR 1941.

(2) Native American Grave

End of East Slope Road and Washington Avenue. One burial dated by radiocarbon test to 1550 A.D. Data-Bayville Village Historian, TOB 1961.

Bethpage

(3) Stymus Family Cemetery

Norcross Ave and south side of Revere Avenue. Inscriptions-Meigs 1938.

(3A) Powell Cemetery

Cemetery is located on the old Grumman plant property about a quarter mile west of the Bethpage Community Park. Letter in June 1953 Long Island Forum says cemetery was located "alongside of the Grumman Air Plane Plant." Gersham Saxton was reported by a descendant to be buried there. Contains more than 20 Powell family graves. One stone has a carved finger pointing skyward with the words "going home". Inscriptions-Meigs 1938, page 104A.

Brookville

(4) African-American Cemetery

Southwest side of Brookville Road approx. 2,500 ft NW of Rte 106. Inscriptions-TOB 1961, only one readable stone (Henry T. R. died 1886).

(5) **Dodge Family Cemetery**

Southwest side of Brookville Road approx. 1,000 ft northwest of Rte 106. Dodge, Baker, Wiggins, Brown families. Earliest stones 1807. Inscriptions-TOB Nov. 19, 1961.

(6) Tappentown Cemetery AKA Nostrand-Waldron Cemetery

400 feet south of Cedar Swamp Road, 400 feet east of Cowpath and 500 feet west of Fruitledge Road.

Cemetery dates to 1777. Oldest readable stone in 1968 was dated 1806, last known burial 1873. Tappen, Davis, Waldron, Nostrand, Thorne families. Three Tappen family graves removed to Brookville Cemetery before 1903.

Inscriptions-TOB 1963 with supplements from Stoutenburgh's *Documentary History of the Dutch Congregation at Oyster Bay*.

(7) Titus Burial Ground

Between Rolling Drive and Wheatley Road on grounds of Robin Hood Country Day School.

Titus, Hinman, Crooker families, earliest stone 1805.

Inscriptions-DAR June 1950; TOB December 3, 1961 supplemented with information from family descendants; TOB 1969 site map of 26 graves.

Centre Island

(8) Ludlam Cemetery

Off Centre Island Road 19 stones from early 1700s. Inscriptions-DAR 1941; TOB October 27, 1961.

(9) Smith Cemetery

Off Centre Island Road.

Contains grave of Daniel Smith, veteran of War of 1812.

Inscriptions-DAR 1941; TOB 36 stones copied October 27, 1961.

Cove Neck

(10) Smith Family Cemetery

North end of Cove Neck Road where road makes sharp right turn. Approx. 19 stones from 1855 through 1953. Inscriptions Frost 1912; DAR 1941; TOB Nov. 16, 1961.

East Hills/Old Brookville

(11) Townsend Cemetery

100 yards south of Rte 25A about one mile west of Whitney Lane. Cemetery straddles the line that separates the Town of Oyster Bay and the Town of North Hempstead. Earliest stone Timothy Townsend died 1790; other families include Horsfield and Jackson. Property was under development when 1961 survey was done and surveyors took special care to record all data as they believed the site would soon be destroyed. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; TOB 1961 (in very poor condition in 1961 when fragments were copied).

East Norwich (Also see Muttontown)

(12) Elbert Hegeman Cemetery

Rear of north end of shopping center, east side of Rte 106.

Cemetery named after Major Elbert Hegeman 3rd N.Y. Prov. Cavalry, Civil War who is buried here. Rutgers Hegeman 84th Reg. NY Vol. Civil War also buried here. Inscriptions-DAR 1941; TOB November 3, 1961.

(12A) Franklin/Wright Family Cemetery

Was formerly located on the east side of Mill River Road, about 900 feet south of Northern Boulevard. Family remains were reburied at Brookville Cemetery in the "Old Section", lot 96.

(13) Oak Hill Cemetery

Formerly located on north side of Sugar Tom's Lane. Stones removed to St. John's Episcopal Church Cemetery (From TOB notes 1961).

Farmingdale

(14) **Bethpage Cemetery**

Quaker Meeting House Road near Merritt Road, south side of road westerly of three adjacent cemeteries. Eardeley copied inscriptions on 15 June 1898 and stated there were 246 stones plus a significant number of graves without stones. His transcriptions appear to have combined this cemetery along with the Friends Burial Ground (16) and the Powell Family Cemetery (17) into one record.

Inscriptions-Eardeley, Wm. A., 1918; Queensborough Public Library.

Although the Bethpage Cemetery Association is inactive, burials continue because of family ownership of burial plots.

(15) Cornelius Cemetery

North side of Fulton Street between Cobb Pl and Doud Street.

Inscriptions-Eardeley, Wm. A., 1918; Queensborough Public Library. Eardeley described the cemetery as being "in wretched condition" in 1894. There were 19 stones in 1894 with burials dating from 1839.

Cemetery Inactive-maintained by Village of Farmingdale.

(16) Friends Burial Ground

Quaker Meeting House Road; south side of road by meeting house. Meeting house was built 1743 according to Nassau County Historian Jesse Merritt (see Long Island Forum December 1956, page 231). Cemetery dates to early 1700s.

Burials in this guide were extracted from *Encyclopedia of American Quaker Genealogy*. Active. Also see Eardeley transcriptions. Records kept by Clerk of Bethpage Friends Meeting.

(17) **Powell Family Cemetery**

Southwest corner Quaker Meeting House Road and Thomas Powell Blvd. Inscriptions-Meigs 1938 Also see Eardeley transcriptions. Active. Powell Cemetery Corp.

(18) Van Cott Cemetery

Northeast corner Grant Avenue and Rose Street.

Burials date from 1819.

Inscriptions-Eardeley, Wm. A., 1918; Queensborough Public Library.

Inactive, maintained by Village of Farmingdale.

Glen Cove

(19) Albertson Family Cemetery

Town Path. 3 stones all Wrights, 1827-1855. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; TOB 1961.

(20) Coles Family Cemetery

Formerly located in the parking lot of Columbia Ribbon and Carbon Company. The granite stone marking the death on April 16, 1715 of Robert Coles was removed to private property in 1954 by Robert R. Coles, bulldozers then leveled the property destroying the remaining graves (Long Island Forum, page 166, September 1954). Inscriptions-Frost 1912.

(20A) Coles Cemetery

Highland Road, adjoining St. Paul's Episcopal Church Cemetery. Inscriptions-Frost 1912.

(21) Craft Cemetery

South of Craft Heights near Cecil Avenue.

William H. Carpenter, 2nd NY Inf Civil War, died July 27, 1913 was interred here. Inscriptions-DAR 1941 10 stones; TOB April 11, 1954 only 7 stones remained.

(22) Dickson Cemetery

Pearsall Avenue and LIRR tracks.

On August 12, 1955 P. L. Van Santvoord interviewed former Glen Cove Mayor Dr. James Burns about this cemetery. Dr. Burns related that as a boy he recalled mounds but no stones. During construction of the Arterial Highway efforts were made to locate the old graves which were believed to be 200-300 years old and contained the graves of some of the original settlers of Glen Cove. The search and digging only revealed what was believed to be a layer of fine bone dust which was placed in a box and interred in the Dickson family plot of St. Paul's Church Cemetery.

(23) St. Paul's Episcopal Church Cemetery

Highland Road

Hall family inscriptions copied 1950 DAR. Cemetery was consecrated in 1834 but the oldest stone is dated 1801 (From TOB notes 1961). Charles A. Dana, editor of the New York Sun is buried here (Long Island Forum, March 1960). Active.

(23A) **Hyde Family Cemetery**

Highland Road, adjoining St. Paul's Episcopal Church Cemetery. Inscriptions-Frost 1912.

(24) Garvie Cemetery

Garvie's Point Road

Some stones lost due to housing development, remaining inscriptions copied 1955 TOB.

(25) Landing Cemetery

South of McLaughlin Street and east of Landing School. Obliterated by Dickson Gardens Development (1953) 12 remaining stone inscriptions copied 1953 TOB.

(26) Miller Cemetery

Formerly located behind No. 12 Hillside Avenue. 11 graves re-interred at unknown location to make way for urban renewal project in 1961. One of these graves was of John E. Miller who died a prisoner at Andersonville, Ga. during Civil War. Inscriptions-TOB 1961.

(27) Townsend Cemetery AKA Duck Pond Cemetery

On the grounds of Nassau Country Club. The earliest burial was of William Townsend who died in 1777 on his Duck Pond Farm. Townsend, Cock, Valentine, Covert, others. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; TOB November 1, 1961.

(28) Weeks Cemetery

Formerly was located west of Red Spring Lane. No trace of actual site remains. Three graves were removed to St. Paul's Churchyard between 1833 to 1836 (From TOB notes 1961).

(29) Woolsey Cemetery

North end of Dosoris Lane. According to Peter L. Van Santvoord the cemetery was moved from its original location. (see Long Island Forum March 1957, page 51). Josephine Frost, on page 36 of her Frost Genealogy, describes its location in 1912 as "Locust Grove, Dosoris, L.I." Cemetery contains graves of three veterans of Colonial Wars including Melancthon Taylor Woolsey who died in 1758 while battling the French, also Lt. Col. Charles W. Woolsey veteran of Civil War. Still in use in 1950s. Woolsey family inscriptions copied by DAR 1941. Colonial stones inscriptions copied 1955 TOB (Pages 4 and 16-18, 85).

(30) Wright Cemetery

Vicinity of Summit Place.

Contained burials of relatives of Joshua Wright. Destroyed in July 1930 during construction of Brewster Street (Glen Cove Echo-July 1930). Plowed under many years ago (TOB notes 1961).

(31) Calvary African Methodist Episcopal Church Cemetery

West side of Piping Rock Road near Frost Pond Road.

Deed filed in Queens County 1887. TOB notes of 1961 states last of local Indians buried here.

Placque at entrance on Piping Rock Road reads:

"Calvary African Methodist Episcopal Church Cemetery

Formerly known as Youngs Cemetery.

Purchased by the church in 1875 from members of the Cock family.

Among those who share this ground as their final resting place are veterans from the Civil War, World War I and World War II.

Earliest recorded burial 1870.

Restored in 2000 by The Matinecock Neighborhood Association.

Maintained by Friends Academy."

No known transcription records.

Glen Head

(32) Jotham Townsend Cemetery

Off Jaeger Drive, Glen Head.

Obliterated by housing development. Jotham Townsend veteran of Revolutionary War buried here, no stone remains; also his wife Deborah who died in 1841 at age 96; she was daughter of John Kirk of Norwich who was in Provost prison during Revolutionary War. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; 5 remaining stones copied July 19, 1955 TOB. A visit by the Townsend Society to the cemetery site in the spring of 2005 revealed no trace of any remaining stones.

(33) Native Burial Ground

West of Cedar Swamp Road between Hillside Cemetery and Chicken Valley Road. A cemetery of Indian graves with standing fieldstone monuments was located here until about 1910 (From TOB notes 1961).

(34) Townsend Cemetery

West side of Hillside Avenue off Glen Head Road.

Early 1800s through 1942.

Inscriptions Frost 1912; TOB October 29, 1961.

Glenwood Landing

(35) Mott Family Cemetery

North side of Scudder's Lane, south end of Mott Place. On Town of North Hempstead border.

All Mott family, earliest stone 1822.

Inscriptions-DAR 1941, 1950; TOB 1961.

Hicksville

(36) Hicksville Community Mausoleum AKA Plainlawn Cemetery

279 West Old Country Road.

Originally incorporated in mid 1800s as Heitz Family Cemetery. Some stones date to 1840s.

Active. Records at cemetery office.

Jericho

(37) Townsend Cemetery

West side of Jericho Turnpike west of old turnpike intersection.

TOB 1961 records that stones were piled up near site.

(38) Jericho Friends Cemetery

108 Old Jericho Turnpike, behind Friends Meeting House.

Elias Hicks, the Quaker Reformer is buried here.

Burials in this guide were extracted from *Encyclopedia of American Quaker Genealogy*. Records kept by Clerk of Jericho Friends Meeting.

Lattingtown

(39) Cherrywood Drive Cemetery AKA Dodge-Weeks Cemetery or Weeks Cemetery

Alongside garage of 12 Cherrywood Drive, off Bayville Road, near Egypt Lane. Contains grave of Captain Joseph Weekes veteran of Colonial Wars. Transcription record in Town Historian's Office by Josephine Frost in 1910 reads, "This cemetery is abandoned, being used as a pasture. Many stones are unreadable and evidences are visible of many unmarked graves, owing to the Quaker belief of this family."

Inscriptions copied October 27, 1961 TOB-43 standing stones plus 12 fragments, many stones were unreadable.

(40) Cock Family Cemetery

Corner of Horse Hollow Road and Bayville Road. Re-interred at Locust Valley Cemetery (TOB notes 1961).

(41) Dosoris Cemetery AKA Pratt Family Cemetery

Old Tappan Road. On private property about 250 yards north of St. John's of Lattingtown Church. TOB notes 1961.

(42) Eden Rock Drive Cemetery

Alongside property at 6 Eden Rock Drive. Contains graves of Cock family and others. TOB notes 1961.

(43) Frost Family Cemetery

On property of Creek Club. Frost family members buried near 16th green, slaves buried by 15th hole.

Contains grave of Captain Wright Frost veteran of Colonial Wars. William Frost settled here in 1673 and began the cemetery. Oldest stone dates 1720. Frost family slaves reportedly buried without markers on north slope of knoll above cemetery. Frost, Redmond, Cock, Townsend, Bayles plus other families. Note by Josephine Frost in 1910 reads, "This cemetery is on the farm purchased by William Frost, about 1670, the title of which never passed from the direct descendants until about 1900 when it was purchased by Mr. Paul D. Cravath. It is known that the pioneer and his wife are buried here but no stones show the exact location of their graves, but in the enclosure of evergreens are many unmarked mounds, probably of those of the third generation who remained faithful to their Orthodox Ouaker faith."

Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR copied readable inscriptions in 1941. TOB copied readable inscriptions Nov. 8, 1961 and supplemented inscriptions with information from Frost, Cocks and Underhill Genealogies.

(44) Latting Family Cemetery

Lattingtown Road near Frost Creek Drive.

Private, on property of Latting House, many stones removed by later generations and used elsewhere. Two stones re-used at St. Paul's Church Cemetery, Glen Cove (TOB notes 1961).

Inscriptions-Frost 1912.

(45) Locust Valley Cemetery

Ryefield Road near Reformed Church, Locust Valley.

Originally the cemetery of the Reformed Church. Earliest burials in 1700s. Incorporated 1917 and operated by the Locust Valley Cemetery Association. Inscriptions-DAR 1941; Kassner 1993. Active.

(46) Meudon Drive Cemetery

Meudon Drive off Frost Creek Drive

Contains single stone standing by a tree (1940). James W. son of James and Eleanor Treadwell-died 31 Dec 1839 age 15.
Inscriptions DAR 1941.

(47) **Peacock-Germain Cemetery**

At Peacock Point.

No trace remains of this cemetery. Three Germain family stones (Daniel died 1851, Elizabeth died 1866 and John died 1870) were removed to Locust Valley Cemetery about 1900 (TOB notes 1961). Inscriptions-Frost 1912.

(48) Peter Cock Family Cemetery

Bayville Road just north of Factory Pond Road.

Contains Cock family burials 1800s. Josephine Frost transcription record of 1910 reads, "About twenty graves are simply marked with sticks and there is one old stone with "P" visible on it. This cemetery is in the midst of thick woods near the old Cock homestead, in Oyster Bay Township."

Inscriptions-Frost 1912; TOB November 2, 1961.

(49) St. John's of Lattingtown Episcopal Church Cemetery

Overlook and Lattingtown Roads.

Established 1923. Active.

(50) Underhill Burying Ground

Entrance off Factory Pond Road in Mill Neck but cemetery is in Lattingtown. Land deeded to Captain John Underhill in 1667. Monument to Captain John Underhill dedicated by President Theodore Roosevelt on July 11, 1908. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR 1941; *The Underhill Burying Ground*.

(51) Weeks Cemetery

Bayville Road near Sheep Lane. This description is given in Frost records of 1912, however there are no separate inscription records and this is believed to be an erroneous description of the Dodge-Weeks Cemetery (No. 39).

Laurel Hollow

(52) **Dodge Burial Ground**

Corner of Moore's Hill Road and Stewart Lane. 2 gray slate stones, both for Ebenezer Dodge, died May 6, 1748 age 62. Inscriptions-TOB 1962.

(53) Memorial Cemetery of St. John's Church

Rte 25A and Cove Road.

Partial inscriptions-Frost 1912. Active.

(54) St. John's Church Cemetery AKA Jones Cemetery

On grounds of St. John's Episcopal Church, located on hill behind church. Jones, Hewlett and other families. Inscriptions-DAR 1941; TOB June 22, 1962.

(55) St. John's Negro Cemetery

Harbor Road (route 108) near corner of Lawrence Hill Road.

This cemetery is actually within the bounds of Suffolk County but was historically connected with the Jones family and St. John's Church. Burials here were reported to be of slaves who worked for the Jones family. One marker (A.T.) was for Alfred Thorn who died Feb. 3, 1900 age 55 years. Records describe him as a dwarfed hunchback who worked as a coachman for the Jones family.

Data from TOB-May 30, 1962. DAR recorded two grave markers in 1941, Patience Thorn died 1872 age 72 and Alfred Thorn died 1900 age 55.

(56) Velsor Cemetery

Approx. one mile west of Rte 108 on north side of Stillwell Lane.

In Specimen Days, Walt Whitman wrote the following about the Velsor Cemetery; "My grandfather Cornelius and my grandmother Amy (Naomi) and numerous relatives nearer or remoter, on my mother's side, lie buried here." Whitman recorded in 1881 that there were 40 to 60 graves visible. Cemetery is located on private property and only one footstone remains today.

Inscriptions-DAR 1941; TOB 1963.

Locust Valley

(57) Tilley Cemetery

Off property at 21 Kaintuck Lane.

Contains about 14 stones, all Tilley family; dates range from 1775 to 1865. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR 1941, 1950; TOB 1961.

Massapequa

(58) Jones Family Cemetery

South side of Merrick Road between Ocean and Massapequa Avenues.

Jones family burial ground since 1779. Col. Benjamin Birdsall officer in Revolutionary War and Samuel Jones, considered the "Father of the New York Bar" are buried here. Inscriptions-Meigs 1938; Historical Society of the Massapequas 1994.

(59) Floyd-Jones Cemetery

On grounds of Old Grace Church, north side of Merrick Road.

Earliest stone Thomas Jones interred 1713 at Brick House Creek, grave moved in 1836 to this site. Active for Floyd-Jones family.

Inscriptions-Historical Society of the Massapequas 1994.

(59A) Fort Neck Burial Site

Between Sunset Boulevard and Fairfax Road.

Site of ancient Indian fortification. Numerous human remains reportedly unearthed in 1930s. Thomas Jones originally buried here in 1713, body removed to Grace Church Cemetery in 1836. Site designated National Historic Landmark on April 19, 1993.

(60) Grace Church Cemetery

On grounds of Old Grace Church, north side of Merrick Road.

Active 20th century cemetery. Records at church.

Matinecock

(61) Friends Matinecock Meeting Cemetery

East side of Piping Rock Road, corner of Duck Pond Road.

Cemetery dates to 1726. 17 Quaker locust post markers remained in 1961. Transcription by Josephine Frost in 1910 reads, "The Matinecock Meeting House was established in 1725 and the Burying Place a year later and the early settlers are without doubt buried in it, but the "Friends" at that period did not allow any graves to be marked." Active. Records-Clerk, Matinecock Friends Meeting.

Mill Neck

(62) Cock Cemetery

West side of Beaver Dam, south of the road.

Re-interred at Locust Valley Cemetery. Some of the men buried here were seven feet tall (From TOB notes 1961).

(63) **Dove-Howell-Hall Cemetery**

Cleft Road, on hill above ponds.

Grave of Aaron Howell (1756-1841) veteran of Revolutionary War, Mohawk Valley Campaign.

Inscriptions-TOB 1961.

(64) Ludlam Family Cemetery

West Shore Road.

Weeks, Ludlam, Boyce families. Earliest burial 1830.

Inscriptions-DAR 1941. TOB Nov. 10, 1961.

(65) Native Burial Ground

Factory Pond Road at Corn Creek.

Graves of Indians or slaves of Underhill family found here (TOB notes 1961).

(66) Thomas Cock Cemetery

Was located on east side of Mill Neck Creek near Beaver Dam causeway.

Inscriptions-Frost 1912. DAR 1941. Stones moved in 1943 to Locust Valley Cemetery. 30 Inscriptions recorded at time of removal-TOB 1961.

(67) Townsend Cemetery AKA Council Rock AKA Mill Hill Cemetery

Lake Avenue west of Council Rock

Henry Townsend, who built the first mill in 1661, was buried here in 1695 (marker no longer visible). Townsend, Butler, Wooden families. Cemetery deeded to the Town of Oyster Bay by Henry Townsend October 17, 1740.

Inscriptions-DAR 1941; TOB November 6, 1961.

(68) Weeks Cemetery Site

East of Frost Mill Road, south of Cleft Road

Inscriptions-TOB 1963. Eight fieldstones remained, only two were then readable. M. W. d. 1749 and Michael Weeks d. 1747.

Muttontown

(69) Lewis Family Cemetery

On north side of Rte 25, west of Underhill Blvd.

Approx. 15 graves. Beatty, Lewis families.

Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR 1941; TOB December 21, 1961.

(70) Locust Cemetery 1816

West side of Rte 106, south of Muttontown Road.

Duryea family burial ground. Contains graves of Civil War and World War I veterans. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; Meigs 1938, page 96; DAR 1941; TOB 1961.

(71) Methodist Church Cemetery

East side of Rte 106, opposite Locust Avenue, East Norwich.

This was originally the Horton family cemetery with earliest burial in 1816. Land for church and cemetery purchased November 10, 1835. Vernon, Waldron, Hawxhurst, Martling families, plus others. Several Civil War veterans buried here. 39 graves moved in 1914 to Memorial Cemetery in Laurel Hollow, 9 graves went to East Hillside Cemetery and then later to Memorial Cemetery, Laurel Hollow.

Inscriptions-Frost 1912; "Gov" Vernon 1930s; Meigs 1938, page 58.

Records at Community United Methodist Church, East Norwich.

(72) Monfort Family Cemetery

Close to Rte 106 just below Methodist Church Cemetery.

Horton and Monfort family graves.

Inscriptions-Frost 1912.

(73) Weekes-Ficken Cemetery

North side of Muttontown Road opposite Woodhollow Ct.

Weekes, Ficken, Silvey, Pedersen families. Earliest stones from 1830s. Site enclosed by fence with padlocked gate (1961).

Inscriptions-DAR 1941; TOB Nov.26, 1961.

(74) **Private Burial Ground**

North side of 25A.

This cemetery was mentioned in the AMHNYS cemetery project, but no other information could be learned about its specific location or inscriptions.

Old Brookville

(75) East Hillside Cemetery

East side of Cedar Swamp Road at intersection of Glen Cove Road.

Selected as family burial plot about 1721 by Adriaen Hegeman. Earliest stones date to 1740s. Organized by deed in 1749 as a public cemetery. Peter Luyster, died 1834, veteran of Battle of Long Island in Revolutionary War buried here. Several Hessian soldiers who died from smallpox were buried here in unmarked graves during Revolutionary War. Active-operated by East Hillside Cemetery Association.

Inscriptions-TOB 1961, eighteenth century stones transcribed.

Old Westbury

(76) Crooker Cemetery

South side of Wheatley Road opposite end of Whitney Lane.

Four Crooker family graves 1811-1842. Inscriptions-TOB November 16, 1961.

(77) Layton Cemetery

Wheatley Road, near No. 40.

No stones remained as of 1961. Two stones were reported lying flat in 1930s, no information was recorded (TOB notes 1961).

Oyster Bay

(78) **Baptist Church Cemetery**

Orchard Street and Spring Street, entered through right of way to left of 64 Orchard Street. Cemetery is located on lot laid out to Nicholas Wright in 1653. Cemetery lot deeded to Baptist Church in 1720 by William Wright. Earliest readable stone 1749. Cemetery contains graves of Molly Cooper and Rev. Marmaduke Earle; also Captain Abraham Van Wyck of Revolutionary War. Wright, Earle, Cooper, Townsend, Underhill, plus other families.

Inscriptions-DAR 1941; TOB Nov.12, 1961.

(78A) Quaker Burial Ground

South Street, west side.

The Quaker or Friend's Burial Ground was established by a deed of gift from Anthony Wright to Alice Crabb, Hannah Wright, Mary Andrews and others in 1672. The burial ground was six poles square and on the northeast corner of Anthony Wright's home lot. In the same deed he also gifted a parcel of forty feet square at the southeast part of his home lot as a site for a meeting house. No Quaker graves were marked prior to 1852 and

(88) White-Larrabee Cemetery AKA East Main Street Cemetery

North side of East Main Street, east of Harbor Road.

White, Colwell, Larrabee, Minor families. Contains gravestone of Mary White who died September 27, 1699 age 17 years 6 months. James Colwell, Oyster Bay's first postmaster buried here. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR 1941; TOB Nov. 4, 1961.

Oyster Bay Cove

(89) Fleet Family Cemetery

Cove Road, west of Yellow Cote Road. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR Nov. 1941; TOB November 11, 1961.

(90) Horton-Wortman Cemetery

In field on northeast side of Sandy Hill Road on former Schiff estate. Wortman and Hamilton families 1841-1900, 9 graves. Inscriptions-TOB May 1960 and November 4, 1961.

(91) Weekes Cemetery

East side of Sandy Hill Road.

Property was deeded as cemetery in 1837 but was in use by Weeks, Latten, Albertson families earlier. Parish, Ludlam, Smith and other families. Six generations of Weeks buried here with Charles Weeks (died 1831) being the last per Kathleen W. Underhill in the October 1976 edition of *Bulletin of the Underhill Society of America*. Inscriptions-DAR 1941; TOB November 9, 1961.

(92) Youngs Memorial Cemetery

West side of Cove Road opposite Cove Neck Road.

Set aside as a graveyard in 1658, incorporated March 26, 1900. Grave of Theodore Roosevelt, 26th President of the United States, is in Youngs Memorial Cemetery. Contains graves of Youngs family slaves, veterans of Revolutionary War, Civil War and Spanish-American War.

Inscriptions Frost 1912; eighteenth century stone inscriptions copied 1961 TOB. Mary Jane Layton Lippert 1999. Records-Youngs Memorial Cemetery Corporation.

Plainedge (Bethpage)

(93) Combes Cemetery

Unknown location.

Inscriptions-Meigs 1938, page 91.

(94) Methodist Church Cemetery AKA Lyceum Cemetery

North side of Hempstead Turnpike between Hicksville Road and Stewart Avenue. Church ceased operations prior to 1893. Building then became meeting place for the Lyceum. Alfred S.Walters first Farmingdale Civil War casualty (died 1865) buried here. Inscriptions-DAR 1941.

Plainview

(96) Cynthia Lane Cemetery

North side of Cynthia Lane 150 feet west of Hope Drive. Reportedly a native American burial site (TOB 1961).

the Oyster Bay Friends Meeting ceased before that date. The only known burials are extracted from notations in the *Oyster Bay Town Records*.

(79) Christ Church

East Main Street

(Cemetery and Memorial Garden)

Six Doughty (Doty) family burials 1751-1808 plus four stones of other families. Two stones are located under the church building, one of which is dated 1756. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR Nov. 1941; TOB November 5, 1961.

(80) First Presbyterian Church

East Main Street.

Four graves of Wooden family pre-date the church on this site. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR Nov. 1941; TOB 1961.

(81) Fort Hill Cemetery

South side of the east end of Simcoe Street.

Earliest burial John Townsend 1668 who was buried on his own land. Many stones date to 1700s. Robert Townsend, Revolutionary War spy buried here. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR 1941; TOB October 25, 1961.

(82) McCoun Cemetery

Sandy Hill Road and Agnes Street.

McCoun family and others, burials from mid 1700s. Chancellor William T. McCoun, first New York State Republican Party Chairman buried here. Also grave of Sophia Moore, born a slave in New Jersey, died OB 1851.

Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR 1941; TOB November 3, 1961.

(83 Parish Cemetery

Southeast corner of Berry Hill Road and Rte 106.

Abandoned, seven stones moved to Fort Hill cemetery, bodies remain on site. (From TOB notes 1961).

(84) Pine Hollow Cemetery

West side Pine Hollow Road, south of Mill-Max.

Contains graves of 7 veterans of colored regiments of Civil War.

Inscriptions-Frost 1912. Active.

(85) Sampson-Adam-Folger Cemetery

West side of Lexington Avenue behind Landmark Colony.

9 stones from 1827 to 1906.

Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR 1941; TOB November 6, 1961.

(86) Shadbolt Cemetery

West side of Lexington Avenue between West Main Street and Mill River Road. Contains single stone, Robert Shadbolt died 1729 and Anne Shadbolt died 1729. Inscriptions-TOB 1961.

(87) Townsend-Wortman Cemetery

Between Harbor and Anchorage Lanes within Top of the Harbor co-op.

Stones from 1740s through 1850s. Contains grave of Captain Tunis Wortman veteran of Colonial Wars who died in 1775. Colonel Coles Wortman and Captain James Farley, veterans of Revolutionary War also buried here.

Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR November 25, 1941; TOB October 1961 (recheck of DAR 1941).

(97) St. Margaret's Cemetery

1000 Washington Avenue. Active 20th century cemetery.

(98) Van Wyck Cemetery

Rear of No. 16 Pound Ridge Road, off Washington Avenue. Single inscribed stone, Richard Van Wyck died April 8, 1854 in 42nd year. Inscriptions-Meigs 1938, page 104B; TOB 1995, only some broken pieces of marble remained.

Sea Cliff

(99) Bryant Avenue Cemetery

Off Bryant Avenue, just east of Our Lady of Kazan Church.

Cemetery was reported as vanished in 1961 Town of Oyster Bay Historian's study. That report commented that the cemetery reportedly dated to time of Cromwell and that remaining stones had been carted away when area was developed in 1950s. Sea Cliff Village Museum reports the finding of parts of a skeleton of an Indian girl about age 10 on this site of a former Indian Burial Ground. New York State Office of Historic Preservation has given the site the Unique Site Number A05976.000081. Site information available at Sea Cliff Village Museum.

(100) Carpenter Cemetery

Behind Sea Cliff Elementary School bounded on south by Littleworth Lane, on west by Brengel Place, on north by Franklin Ave.

Cemetery laid out in 1855, first stone dated 1861. John F. Morris, Navy veteran of Civil War buried here. Burial records at Sea Cliff Village Museum. Inscriptions-Meigs 1938, page 85; TOB November 1, 1961.

(101) Kirby-Mott Cemetery

On private property on Bryant Avenue between Willow Shore Road and Shore Road (Prospect Avenue). Some stones reportedly removed. Dorothy Martin letter of September 21, 1981 states earliest readable stone is Samuel Harrold died 1794. Roper, Downing and Kirby family burials mentioned in letter. Excavations in 1956 revealed native American artifacts and human remains believed to be native American; artifacts and bones were turned over to the Smithsonian Institution in 1968 and are now part of the exhibit in the Heye Foundation collection on display at the Museum of American Indians. New York State Office of Historic Preservation has given the site the Unique Site Number A05976.000082.

Site information available at Sea Cliff Village Museum.

Syosset

(102) Cheshire Cemetery

Between Miller Road, Edward Lane and Ira Road. Heavily vandalized by 1961. Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR 1941; TOB fragments copied 1961.

(103) Schenck Cemetery

South of Jericho Turmpike at Jackson's Corner 4 Schenck family burials 1877-1895. Inscriptions-DAR 1941.

(104) Schenck Family Cemetery

West of Our Lady of the Angels Home, approx. 300 ft north of Convent Road.

Inscriptions-Frost 1912; DAR 1941; TOB June 23, 1962 plus additions Dec. 3, 1975.

(105) Unnamed Cemetery

Corner of Miller Road and Colony Lane, north side of Miller west of Colony. No stones or markers remained in 1961(TOB).

Upper Brookville

(106) **Brookville Cemetery**

Corner of Rte 25A and Wolver Hollow Road.

Cemetery established by deed from Jurian Haff to Dutch Reformed Church in 1750. Contains grave of Captain David Layton and four other veterans of Revolutionary War plus many veterans of Civil War. Early records of burials recorded in Stoutenburgh's Documentary History of the Dutch Congregation at Oyster Bay. Later records available through the Brookville Cemetery Association. Active.

Inscriptions-Frost 1912. Earliest section, known as The Dutch Burying Ground, inscriptions and burial locations with maps, M.J. Lippert, 1994, 1995.

(107) Reynolds Family Cemetery

On grounds of Mill River Country Club. On a hill are two stones, Richardson Reynolds (died 1831) and his wife Eleanor (died 1845).

Inscriptions copied 1961 TOB.

(108) St. Patrick's RC Cemetery

Chicken Valley Road, east of Piping Rock Road. Established 1871, earliest stones date to 1870s. Active. Records-Director of Cemeteries, Diocese of Rockville Centre.

(109) Silleck Cemetery

Cannon Lane off Glen Cove-Oyster Bay Road Silleck family burials from early 1800s through 1950s. Inscriptions-DAR 1941; TOB Nov. 4, 1961.

West Amityville

(110) Carman Cemetery AKA County Line Cemetery

North side of Merrick Road east of Carman Road. (Burials moved) Inscriptions-Meigs 1938.

Woodbury

(111) Borland-Hewlett Burying Ground

Formerly located near corner of Woodbury Road and Jericho Turnpike.

There were ten graves of the Borland and Hewlett families which were removed in 1918 to Jones Memorial Cemetery.

Inscriptions-TOB April 16, 1963 (collected from old records).

(112) Fountain Hill Cemetery

On hillside east of railroad bridge on north side of Woodbury Road.

Dense underbrush, not visible from road (1962). Whitney, Walters, Valentine, Van Sise families. Earliest stone 1806. Contains grave of Major Darling Whitney died Nov. 14, 1834 age 76 (S.A.R. Marker).

Inscriptions-TOB 1962, some stones were not accessible due to very dense vegetation.

(113) Hendrickson Cemetery AKA Nome Cemetery

South side of Jericho Turnpike east of Woodbury Road, intersection of Juneau Blvd to Nome Road. Earliest stone 1819, latest 1867. Inscriptions-TOB June 1, 1962.

(114) Hewlett Cemetery

On hill behind new Woodbury Methodist Church, Woodbury Road. This cemetery was the Hewlett family burial ground and was located on what was called Mt. Nebo. The earliest surviving stone is that of Hannah Hewlett died 1787 age 90. Grave of Captain Charles Hewlett of Revolutionary War is here as is Justice John Hewlett, last of the King's Justices, who was Superintendent of Forage for British Commissary General James Christie in Revolutionary War. Inscriptions-TOB 1962.

(115) Hunting Hill Cemetery

Hunting Hill Road south of Woodbury Road near railroad trestle other side of Drum Works. (1941 description)
Inscriptions-DAR 1941.

(116) Methodist Church Cemetery

Next to former Methodist Church, corner Jericho Turnpike and Woodbury Road. Col. Charles A. Helms, 127th Reg. NY Vol., Civil War died 1901. Earliest stones 1863. Helms, Lewis, Velsor and other families. Designated Town of Oyster Bay Landmark 1998.

Inscriptions-Meigs 1938, page 80; TOB July 6, 1962.

(117) Native American Burying Ground

East side of Pique's Lane on top of hill

TOB 1962, "deserted, no physical evidence. Older residents remember treasure seekers digging for artifacts at the site."

(118) Slave Burial Ground

South side of Stillwell Lane, on brow of hill at western end of Lane. TOB 1962, "a group of stones situated on the brow of a hill reportedly was a slave burying ground."

(119) Valentine Cemetery

North side of Jericho Turnpike across from Woodbury Country Club. Most stones date to mid-1800s. Inscriptions-Meigs 1938, page 83; DAR 1941; TOB June 6, 1962.

(120) Van Sise Cemetery

South of Woodbury-on a hill over looking former Froelich farm (1961) Approx. 15-16 stones, many broken or destroyed by 1961. Readable inscriptions-TOB December 1961. 1986 one headstone and three footstones remained during construction project.

(121) Velsor Burying Ground

On hill south side of Woodbury Road, east of Woodbury Post Office. Inscriptions-TOB 1962, 3 readable stones, was once much larger.

Inscription Records

Various individuals and organizations have made transcriptions of cemetery inscriptions. All of the following references are in manuscript form and have not been previously published. In several cases these manuscripts are all that remain.

DAR-Jennie W. Van Brunt and Annie James of the Daughters of the American Revolution in Oyster Bay transcribed cemetery inscriptions in 1941 and in 1950. Copies of these manuscripts are available at Raynham Hall Museum, West Main Street, Oyster Bay; the Oyster Bay Historical Society; New York State Library, Albany, NY; New York Public Library, New York, NY; DAR Library, Washington, DC; online-Family History Library, Genealogical Society of Utah.

Eardeley-William A. Eardeley of Brooklyn, New York copied gravestones in Bethpage and Farmingdale between 1894 and 1898. His records were printed in manuscript form in April 1918 entitled *Three Cemeteries 1832-1898*, copy is at Queens Borough Public Library. Eardeley appears to have combined the three adjacent cemeteries along Quaker Meeting House Road into one listing.

Frost 1912-Josephine Frost typed transcripts from manuscripts in the possession of William F. Wyckoff who employed a young man to complete the project in about 1902. These were compiled in a document entitled *Long Island Cemetery Inscriptions*, Josephine C. Frost, Queens Borough Public Library. Copy also at NYG&B. Online-Family History Library, Genealogical Society of Utah.

Historical Society of the Massapequas-Complete transcriptions of all stones within the Jones Family Cemetery and the Floyd-Jones Cemetery in Massapequa were done in 1994. All stones were also photographed and placed within binders. P.O. Box 211, 4755 Merrick Road, Massapequa, NY 11758-0211.

Kassner-Douglas Baker Kassner completed A Listing of Gravestones in the Old Section of the Locust Valley Cemetery in 1993. Copy at the Oyster Bay Historical Society.

Lippert-In 1994 Mary Jane Layton Lippert completed a detailed survey of the old section of the Brookville Cemetery, this was expanded the following year. In 1999 *A Study of Youngs Memorial Cemetery* was completed using inscriptions and records. Copy at Oyster Bay Historical Society.

Meigs-Nassau County Cemeteries, 1938; Long Island Collection, Queens Borough Public Library; copy also at NYG&B, New York.

Sea Cliff Village Museum-Sea Cliff, NY 11579, information on Sea Cliff cemeteries and local Indian burial sites.

TOB- Town of Oyster Bay Historian Herbert Hale led a project in 1961-1963 to identify and transcribe all known cemetery inscriptions within the Town of Oyster Bay including the Incorporated Village areas. These manuscripts are available at the Oyster Bay Historical Society and through the office of the Town Historian.

The 8 Volume printed Oyster Bay Town Records are available in most local public libraries. Copies can also be purchased at the Oyster Bay Town Clerk's Office.

Cemetery Index

The Cemetery Index contains several thousand alphabetical listings taken from the DAR, Eardeley, Frost, TOB and other transcription records. The index includes the surname, given name, year of death and cemetery number where the person is buried. In some cases more than one cemetery is listed for a given individual. This is due to the removal of the remains to another cemetery and in a few cases to even a third cemetery. Records for each of those cemeteries should be researched.

Using the cemetery number the researcher can refer back to the cemetery listing section to find the transcription source document and where the record can be located. Transcription documents often contain much more information than just the name of the individual and date of death. Frequently there is mention of the name of the parents, children or marital relationships. When "(Inf)" is listed after a name it indicates an infant death. Maiden names when known or mentioned in the transcriptions are recorded in the cemetery index in parentheses.
