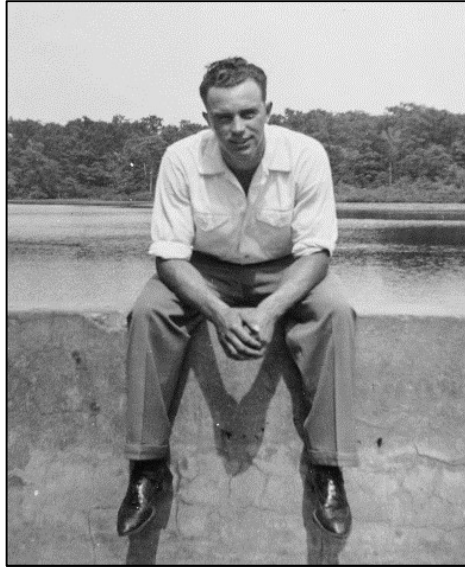

Introduction

This endeavor was inspired by my father, William Francis Howell Jr. He was born in Brooklyn, but at the age of two he moved to St. James with his parents, William Francis and Marion W. Howell. The move to St. James was a reconnection with his Long Island, Howell family roots. My father's great grandmother, Carrie E. (Jones) Jewell, once owned the St. James Hotel. William F. Howell Sr., whose father was born in Port Jefferson, became a Constable in St. James and later an officer in the Smithtown Police Department. In 1931, my father was a boy scout there in Troop #7 of St. James. "Bucky" as Dad was called, was a Wildcat as a volunteer fireman with the St. James Fire Department. As a young man, summers were spent as a lifeguard at Long Beach in Smithtown.

How did he get the name Bucky? Well, the story goes that there was a milkman in St. James nicknamed Bucky. As he stopped by my dad's home for delivery, my dad, who was just a tyke, would call out, "Hi, Bucky!". Bucky, the milkman, would repeat the little boy's call with "Hello Bucky!" From then on, Dad was nicknamed Bucky. As a young man, Bucky worked for Virginia Eckels Malone, the notable Smithtown Historian and one time owner of the Smithtown News. Dad was a lifelong nature-lover, he cherished the stars, plants, birds, beaches, etc. He also had great respect for the Native Americans of Suffolk County and shared that with his children.

Before I was born, Dad served in the U.S. Army as a Technical Sergeant for four years. He was stationed in Panama volunteering to perform Chemical Warfare Testing. My parents moved to New Hyde Park on the Nassau/Queens border, to raise us. It's where my dad became a talented career carpenter in New York City. He worked with hand tools and could build anything; from skyscrapers to doll cradles. He built a large cross for our church that was wrapped with chicken wire. The children of the church slipped flowers into the wire on the cross to make a beautiful floral cross for Easter service. Bucky was a kind, cheerful, and loving man who always helped our neighbors in need.

After his death in 1979, he left behind an interesting assortment of genealogical materials that inspired him, but confused me. You see, he was a beginning genealogist upon his retirement in the 70's. He felt, at

first, that perhaps his family connected to the Edward Howell of Southampton family. He had many friends that he corresponded with, including Gelston Howell and Emma Howell Ross, author of *Descendants of Edward Howell (1584-1655) of Westbury Manor, Marsh Gibbon, Buckinghamshire, and Southampton, Long Island, New York*. He visited graveyards all across Suffolk County, collecting photos and gravestone information of any dearly beloved Howells that were found. He always shared what he found with his Howell researching friends. It must have been difficult researching in this manner, but he loved the hunt. As a retired school librarian, I can't imagine researching now without the help of internet databases.

My sister and fellow researcher, Janice Linda Howell Derr, and I know that he stood at the grave of Shepherd Reeves Howell in the New Village Congregational Church Cemetery. It's unfortunate that he was somehow steered in a mistaken, unproved direction before his death. He relied on some correspondence that indicated yet encouraged documentation, that John Davis Howell could possibly be his great, great grandfather. This lead could not demand his attention, since he was moving to sunny Florida, as do many retired New Yorkers. The move would hinder his research and he was not in good health, so the misconnection was accepted and passed on to his children. If only he would have seen his grandfather's death certificate, he could have begun to discover his true past.

That misconnection, which we believed to be true, was what we passed on to Thomas H. Donnelly for his book *A Genealogy of the Family of Richard Howell Of Mattituck, Southold Town, Long Island, New York To Seven Generations*.

It was only until 2014, on the heels of my retirement that my interest in this genealogical pursuit began. By then, many genealogists had determined the proper connection to Shepherd Reeves Howell. For me, it was a relief to discover that John Davis Howell was not in our line, for there was no evidence of the relationship. Indeed, he was a Richard Howell descendent and a cousin, but not our direct ancestor.

Besides the purpose of correcting our direct link, there was quite a bit of information about the siblings of Shepherd Reeves Howell that became available, since Tom Donnelly's book was written. This has been my focus.

After finally completing this project, I will not say that it is without error and imperfections, but at this time, it is what I was able to conclude based on documentation. Please note that in this book, I am using the name Reeves, with an s, since most documents indicate that spelling, but I do believe that his grandfather was a Reeve, based on his will, and that like many names of the time, was slowly altered by recorders.

I have the highest admiration for Thomas H. Donnelly. His fortitude, commitment and perseverance as an author has encouraged me in my effort. In honor of his amazing work, I wish to continue the quest of sharing this information in good spirit to the best of my ability.

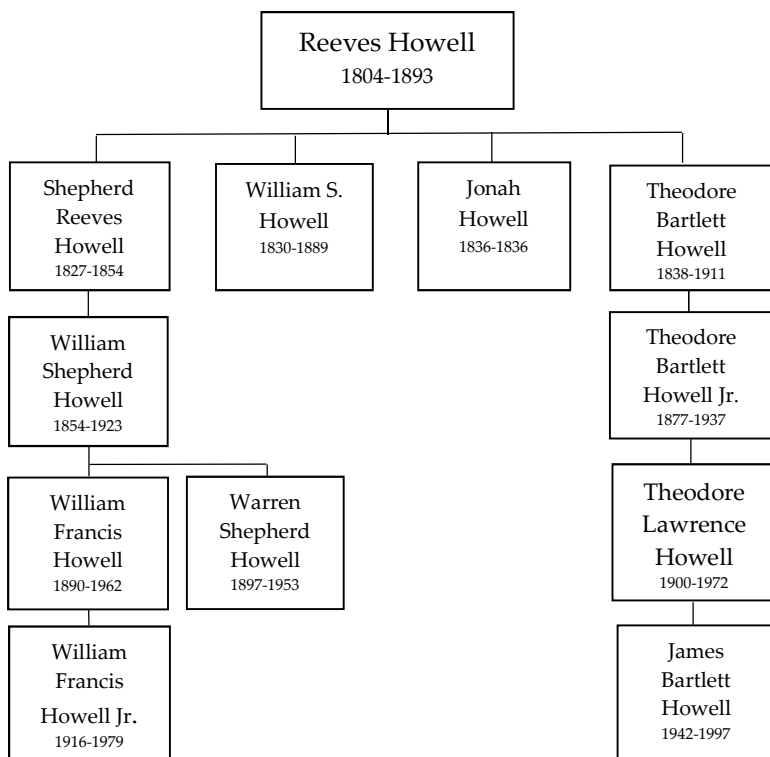

1 (747). SHEPHERD REEVES⁷ HOWELL, (Reeves⁶, James⁵) the son of Reeves and Phebe (Gates) Howell, daughter of Samuel and Zibier/Isebiah/Zerviah (poss. Smith) Gates ₁ of Brookhaven, NY. He was born on 25 Aug 1825, died on 8 July 1854 and is buried at the New Village Congregational Church in Lake Grove, Suffolk, NY where his tombstone₂ is inscribed “Shepherd R. Howell | died Jul. 8, 1854 | AE 26yrs. 10mos. 13 days”

Epitaph

Ye friends that weep around my grave

Compose your minds to rest

Prepare with me for sudden death

In the Fifth Census of the United States 1830, Shepherd Reeve Howell is enumerated as a Male under age 5 with Reeves Howell as Head.₄

In the Sixth Census of the United States 1840, Shepherd Reeves Howell is enumerated as a Male 15 and under 20 with Reeves Howell as Head.₅

In the Seventh Census of the United States 1850, he appears in two locations on two different dates. On August 7, 1850, Town of Brookhaven, listed at Carpenter, age 21, with James M. Bayles, noted Ship Builder and Shipyard owner in Port Jefferson, as Head.₆ On August 21, 1850, Town of Brookhaven, listed as Ship Carpenter, age 23, with Reeves Howell as Head.₇

Shepherd Reeves Howell probably married Caroline E. Jones, b.1832 d.7 Dec. 1913 of New York, although no marriage documentation has been found. Due to fires, many records during the time period in Brookhaven were lost or destroyed. Caroline E. Jones is listed as wife of James Henry Jewell in 1860 United States Federal Census, with a marriage year of 1860.⁸ According to the Death Certificate of Carrie E. (Jewell) Gould, daughter of Caroline E. Jones Jewell, her mother was named Caroline E. Howell.⁹ Caroline E. Jones is buried in the St. James Episcopal Cemetery, St. James, Suffolk, New York.

Shepherd Reeves Howell and wife Caroline E. Jones¹⁰ were the parents of one child.

2 NANCY⁷ HOWELL, (Reeves⁶, James⁵), daughter of Reeves and Phebe (Gates) Howell. Born about 1829 and died 16 Feb. 1902 in Manhattan.¹¹

Married first to Daniel Van Winkle about 1848. Daniel Van Winkle b.10 Feb. 1821 d. 7 Jan. 1864, served and died in service of the Civil War.¹²

Daniel Van Winkle was in the 15th NY Vol Engineers Co F. Enlisted NYC, May 1861; Corp. Jun 1862; SGT Nov 1862; mustered out with company Jun 1863. PVT 5th Regiment NY Artillery. He enlisted in Brooklyn, Dec 1863; unassigned unit; and then died in a Hospital on Riker's Island of disease. Daniel is buried in Cypress Hills National Cemetery in Brooklyn, N.Y.¹³

In the Eighth Census of the United States 1860, Nancy Howell lived in New York City and working as a Tailoress.¹⁴ During that time, according to another Eighth Census of the United States 1860, her two daughters, Adrianna and Emma, resided with her parents, Reeves and Phebe Howell in Brookhaven, Long Island.¹⁵ In yet another Eighth Census of the United States 1860, her son, Daniel Reeves Van Winkle, resided with two of his aunts, sisters of his father, Daniel Van Winkle.¹⁶

Nancy Howell and husband Daniel Van Winkle were the parents of three children.¹⁷

- i **DANIEL REEVES VAN WINKLE** born 24 Oct 1849 in New York. He died 7 Dec 1904 Brooklyn, NY, m: Anna Josephine Fowler, daughter of Thomas Jansen and Anna Fowler, of N.J. b.1858 d.1921. They had two children, Alice Martin (Van Winkle) Stow b.1887 d.1969 and Edith (Van Winkle) Darrow b.1892 d.1979,¹⁸ Daniel Reeves and Anna Van Winkle are buried in Walkill Valley Cemetery, Walden, Orange, NY

Nancy Howell married second William Caldwell,²¹ born 23 Oct. 1833 in NYC. He died 17 Jun. 1904 and is buried in Lake Grove, Long Island, NY at the New Village Congregational Church Cemetery.

3 (748). WILLIAM S.⁷ HOWELL (Reeves⁶, James⁵,) the son of Reeves and Phebe (Gates) Howell. Born about 1830 Brookhaven. He died in Jersey City, Hudson County, New Jersey in 1899 and is buried in the Reformed Dutch Church Cemetery in Bergen, New Jersey.²²

In the Sixth Census of the United States 1840, William S Howell is enumerated as a Male 10 and under 15 with Reeves Howell as Head of the family.²³

In the Seventh Census of the United States 1850, William S. Howell was listed as a son, age 20, who lived with his parents, Reeves and Phebe Howell along with brothers Shepherd R. age 23, Theodore B. age 11, and sister Phebe A. age 13. His occupation is listed as a Seaman.²⁴

In the New York State Census of 1855, William S Howell is listed at age 24 along with his sisters, Nancy Van Winkle, Phebe A. Bertram, their husbands and children all lived in New York City Ward 11 in the same dwelling. Listed occupation as a Stage Driver.²⁵

William married Annie Elizabeth Archibald, daughter of Robert and Elizabeth Archibald of New York, after 1855 and before 1859.

In the Ninth Census of the United States 1870, William Howell is listed at age 38 as a Cartman. He is listed as husband of Ann, age 35, born in NY, lived in the 13th Ward of New York City on Goerlick Street. Listed are two children, Annie 10, Emma 3. Also listed is Ann's mother, Eliza Archibald, age 75.²⁶

In the Tenth Census of the United States of 1880, William S. Howell is listed at age 49 in Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey on Delaware Ave. Wife listed as Annie age 45 with two daughters, Annie age 21 and Alice age 5. William S Howell is listed as a Constable.²⁷

William S. Howell and wife Ann Elizabeth Archibald were the parents of three children.

5 (750). PHEBE ANN⁷ HOWELL (Reeves⁶, James⁵,) the daughter of Reeves and Phebe (Gates) Howell. Born about 1837 in Brookhaven, NY. Phebe Ann married first Charles Bertram b.1831 d.1871, on 28 Mar 1855 and married second John F. Ingraham of Lake Grove. Charles was the son of Sylvanus “Seely” and Betty E. Bertram of Connecticut. John F. Ingraham was the son of Abijah and Maranda (Mead) Ingraham of Lake Grove, Suffolk, NY.

In the Seventh Census of the United States, on 21 Aug 1850, Phebe Ann, age 13, listed as child of Reeves and Phebe Howell. ³⁰

In the Eighth Census of the United States 1860, Phebe Anne, 25 yrs., was the wife of a Hatter from Connecticut named Charles Bertram.³¹

In the Ninth Census of the United States 1870, Phebe Ann lived in Fairfield, Connecticut with her husband Charles Bertram and her son Charles, age 7.³² In historical documents, the name of this Fairfield, Connecticut family was often spelled Bertram, Bartram, Bertum, or Bartrum.

In the Tenth Census of the United States 1880, Phebe Ann, age 43, is widowed and lived in Lake Grove with her father, Reeves Howell age 76 ³³

In the 1900 United States Federal Census, it states that in 1884 Phebe Ann Bertrum age 62, married John F. Ingraham, age 53.³⁴ John F. Ingraham was a 20th Independent Battery NY Light Artillery, Civil War veteran b.1843 d.1921.³⁵ He and Phebe are buried together in Lake Grove, New Village Congregational Church Cemetery.³⁶

In the 1925 Census, Phebe at 87 yrs. lived with Charles and Eliza Bertrum, her son and daughter in law.³⁷

Charles and Phebe Ann (Howell) Bertrum were the parents of one child:

- i. **CHARLES BERTRAM JR.** b. Nov 1864 d. 5 Jun 1942.³⁸ On 9 May 1885 Charles married Eliza Hoyt, daughter of Alexander and Julia (Benedict) Hoyt of Connecticut, b.1864 d.1942. They had one child, John Forester Bertram³⁹ b. 30 Jul 1886 d. 2 Jan 1971 of South Norwalk, Fairfield, Conn. Charles Bertram is buried in Fairfield Memorial Park, Fairfield, Conn.

6 (751). THEODORE BARTLETT⁷ HOWELL (Reeves⁶, James⁵), the son of Reeves and Phebe (Gates) Howell. Born Oct. 1838 Brookhaven. Married Martha M. Weeks, b.1841 d.1925, daughter of Henry and Sophia (Youngs) Weeks of Connecticut, in 1861.

In the Sixth Census of the United States 1840, Theodore Bartlett Howell is enumerated as a male under the age of 5, with Reeves Howell as Head.⁴⁰

In the Seventh Census of the United States 1850, Theodore Bartlett is age 11, son of Reeves and Phebe Howell.⁴¹

In the Eighth Census of the United States 1860, Theodore Bartlett is age 20, a Boatman, and lived in New Village with his parents, nieces Adrianna and Emma, and his nephew William Shepherd Howell.⁴²

In the Ninth Census of the United States 1870, Theodore Bartlett is listed as 30 yrs., and he is an Oysterman. He lived in Norwalk, Fairfield, Connecticut with his wife, Martha, his daughters, Sophie, Adrianna and Florence, his niece Adrianna Van Winkle, and his nephew William Shepherd Howell.⁴³

In the Tenth Census of the United States 1880, Bartlett Howell was listed as age 40 and a Boatman. He lived in East Setauket, Suffolk Co., NY with his wife Martha 33 yrs. and their children; Louise 16 yrs., Florence 12 yrs., and Theodore B. 8yrs.⁴⁴

In the Eleventh Census of the United States 1900, Theodore was age 62 and an Oysterman in New Haven Connecticut. He lived with his wife, his son Theodore, His daughter-in-law Elizabeth, and his grandson Theodore.⁴⁵

In the Twelfth Census of the United States 1910, Theodore was age 70 in Bridgeport, Connecticut with his wife, his daughter Florence (Howell) Bickford, age 42, and his granddaughter Nellie Bickford, age 21. He worked as a Painter in the Boat Industry.⁴⁶

Captain Theodore Bartlett Howell died on 4 Jun 1911 at the age of 72 in Manhattan, New York.⁴⁷ He is buried on Staten Island at Sailor's Snug Harbor Cemetery, New Brighton, Richmond County (Staten Island), New York.⁴⁸

According to newspaper reports, Captain Bart Howell repaired boats. He repaired the sloop Boston for John H. Bickford of Connecticut. He was a music performer with Bert Underhill. They performed at local gatherings in the Setauket area. He was a fisherman who fished for bay scallops in Peconic Bay on Long Island, New York, 1890-1895.⁴⁹

Primary resource, Florence Ruth⁹ (Howell) Fusi, daughter and caretaker of William Shepherd⁸ Howell, claimed that he sailed across the equator four times during his seafaring career. He also raised his nephew, William Shepherd Howell, from a teen to a young man.⁵⁰

Theodore Bartlett and Martha Howell were the parents of four children:

- + 11. i. **SOPHIA LOUISE⁸ HOWELL** born about 1864, New York, and died 16 Nov 1939 in Manhattan, New York.

His mother married James Henry Jewell in 1860, but never counted her first son William, as her son in any of her census documentation. Caroline's ancestry remains unconnected although it is possible, based on an 1840 Huntington census report, that she was the daughter of Cold Spring Harbor's Captain Joshua W. Jones.

In the Eighth Census of the United States, 1860, William is 6 years old and lived with his grandparents, Reeves and Phebe Howell in New Village, Brookhaven. His Uncle Theodore Bartlett "Bart" Howell age 20 yrs., lived with him as did two cousins, Adrianna and Emma Jane Van Winkle, ages 9 and 7.⁵²

In the Ninth Census of the United States, 1870, William was 16 yrs. old and lived with his Uncle Bart in Norwalk, Fairfield, Connecticut along with Bart's wife Martha, their three children; Sophia Louise, Florence Lillian, and Adrianna Howell and his cousin Adrianna Van Winkle.⁵³

William Howell and Elizabeth Barter Woolston were married in Manhattan on Jan 17 1887. "Lizzie" was the daughter of James and Emma Louise Bond of Manhattan. His parents are stated as Shepherd R. Howell and Caroline E. Jones on their marriage certificate.⁵⁴

Theodore Bartlett Howell Jr. was also a pantry man (cook) on many notable steamships. There are numerous passenger lists of him from about 1920 to 1936, traveling to Havana, San Diego, Los Angeles and San Francisco.
