## BENNETT

THIS IS one of East Hampton's oldest names, and largest families. No genealogy of the Bennetts here has ever before been attempted, probably because they did not settle in the village at first, nor were they allotted land until the late 1600's. Dr. Frederick A. Finch is responsible for most of the material used here on the early East Hampton Bennetts. Mrs. Sara Bennett Recktenwald and Mrs. Henry Cullum have been very helpful, with more recent generations. The writer makes no claim that this will be a complete genealogy of this family; that could be a life work; but it is a good try.

Dr. Finch says: "In the visitation of Dorsetshire the Bennetts have been long in England, the names Thomas, John, Edward, and William predominating as they do today." He describes the Bennett coat of arms in England, which included, very appropriately for the shorefront Long Island branch of the family, a whelk shell. The Bennetts are said to have come in the spring of 1639 with Lion Gardiner and lived at first on Gardiner's Island. Therefore they had no need of land in the village. But later, when they grew more numerous, they lived around Three Mile Harbor in the locality now called Squaw Cove, and at Northwest.

The first mention found in E.H. Town Records of a Bennett is Dec. 27, 1659, when David Gardiner, son of the first Lion, and Richard Bennett made a sworn statement in a legal dispute about the contents of a merchant vessel. Richard is mentioned again in 1662, and again—in connection with the Gardiners—in January, 1667.
