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## EDWARDS

ACCORDING TO Pelletreau's "American Families of Historic Lineage", the surname Edwards is of Welsh origin, and was found there as early as 1350. From there, they apparently made their way to England, whence the first American Edwardses came in the early 1600's. In this new land, the Edwards family contributed its full quota—or more—of educators, jurists and divines to the early development of the country, and the current volume of "Who's Who in America" lists Edwardses who are bankers, economists, clergymen, historians and lawyers. The famous Jonathan Edwards of New England was not a direct connection of the Eastern Long Island family, although in the Long Island Collection of the Library there is a small brown book containing a sermon preached by him at the installment of the Reverend Samuel Buell on Sept. 19, 1746: "The Church's marriage to her sons and to her God."

Most of the descendants of that first William Edwards who came to East Hampton from Maidstone in England settled down as farmers or fishermen, and the Amagansett branch contributed several of the last generation of off-shore whalers in the town. Revolutionary War records of Suffolk County included such familiar Edwards names as Daniel, David, Gilbert, John, and Samuel.

The following genealogy has been compiled by Mrs. Amy Osborn Bassford of Wainscott from the writer's own collection of Edwards material, from other material furnished by C. Louis Edwards of East Hampton, Mrs. Abigail Edwards Field, Mrs. Harold Ransom Edwards of Bangor, Maine, Dr. F. A. Finch, and others.

Ch.; Ephraim 3; Thomas 3, d. 1739, ae 67, unmd.; Daniel 3, William 3 who rem. to Cape May, N.J.; Alice 3; Abigail 3; Jane 3; Elizabeth 3; Esther 3. His Will, dated 1698, in East Hampton Town Records. His descendants mostly moved to Cape May, N.J.—no males of this line now living in E.H.

\*He was a weaver, and removed about 1750 to Northeast Precinct, Dutchess Co., N.Y. His Will dated Jan. 29, 1761, proved May 25, 1761.

\*Ebenezer 4 confessed to church covenant 1732; in 1747 he sold his farm at E.H., rem. to Southampton. His Will rec. in N.Y. City.

JEREMIAH 5, (s. of John 4, Thomas 3) bapt. 1728, r. Amagansett. His w. and dau. both d. 1744. He probably married again as he is mentioned in his father's Will as having heirs in 1757.

EBENEZER 5, (s. of Ebenezer 4, William 3) b. about 1736. In 1780 he was a refugee in Farmington, Conn.; later he lived in N.Y. City, unmd.; was known as "Major Ben".

DAVID 5, (s. of Ebenezer 4, William 3) b. about 1744, m. Lucretia Payne of Bridgehampton. Ch.: William 6, b. 1765.

JONATHAN 5, (s. of Timothy 4, John 3) b. Jan. 24, 1759, d. Aug. 31, 1825; b. in Northeast Precinct, Dutchess Co., N.Y., rem. to Conn. after 1765, was christened as an adult in St. Andrews Church, Simsbury, Conn., Nov. 10, 1771. He purchased a farm in West Suffield, Conn., 1783. He m. Sept. 5, 1785, Elizabeth, Dau. of Ezekiel and Elizabeth McMorran Thrall, she b. April 25, 1764, d. June 11, 1851. Ch.: Elizabeth 6 b. Feb. 15, 1786, d. Jan. 15, 1849, m. Abial Cushman; Calle 6, b. Oct. 18, 1790, m. Stephen Griffin; Abijah 6, b. May 10, 1793, d. Aug. 29, 1793; Arnold 6, b. May 18, 1794, d. Feb. 17, 1882; Lydia 6, b.
